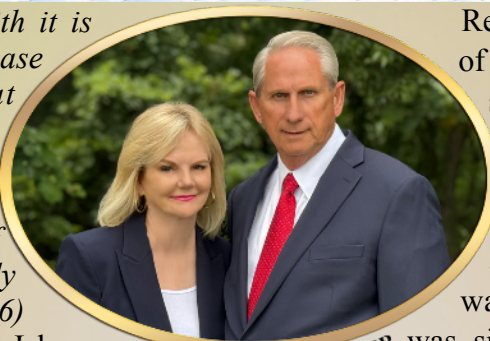

# A TIME OF ACCELERATION

*But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. (Heb. 11:6)*

Over the years, I have learned not to try to come up with or attempt to manufacture a “word” for a season. If the Lord has something He wants to say, He will say it. If He does not, then I am content to stay right where I am and make no changes until He gives instruction. I learned a long time ago that changes made without divine direction often produce confusion rather than progress. God is not obligated to bless plans He never initiated.

There has always been pressure in the church world to hear something new. Sometimes that pressure increases when a new year arrives or when circumstances change. While God certainly speaks concerning times and seasons, He does not do so simply to satisfy curiosity or impatience. When He speaks, it is because what He is saying is necessary. There are so many contradictory words in the church world that someone has to be lying. That is why I greatly hesitate about saying anything. Dad Hagin used to do the same thing until he got in trouble with the Lord.

Recently, during a time of prayer, I was not seeking direction about the year, my ministry, or future plans. I was not asking the Lord what was coming next. I was simply praying. As I did, the Lord began to speak to me quietly, clearly, and deliberately. There was no emotional surge and no sense of urgency to act. What He said carried weight rather than excitement. The Lord said to me, *“This will be a season and a time of acceleration.”*

As He continued to deal with me, it became clear that this word was not limited to my personal life or ministry. This season of acceleration would affect the Body of Christ as well. Things would begin to move more quickly. Matters that once took long periods of time would require less time. Progress that once seemed slow would begin to increase in pace. Even receiving from God would take place more speedily than it had in times past.

It is important to understand that acceleration does not mean disorder. It does not mean rushing ahead, cutting corners, or abandoning God’s order. God does not accelerate confusion.

He accelerates what is aligned with His Word. Acceleration is not God doing something new; it is God allowing things to move more freely where hindrances have been removed. Throughout church history, God has emphasized different aspects of His Word at different times. There have been seasons when healing was emphasized, seasons when faith was emphasized, and seasons when prosperity was emphasized. God does not change, but He does highlight certain truths when they are most needed. In this season, the emphasis is not on novelty but on function—how faith actually works.

One of the first things the Lord impressed upon me is that acceleration is not automatic. God desires increase, but increase does not occur without cooperation. Spiritual laws still govern how faith operates, regardless of the season we are in. A change in season does not override those laws.

*So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. (Romans 10:17)*

Most believers are familiar with this verse, but familiarity can sometimes prevent us from seeing what the Scripture is actually saying. As the Lord dealt with me, He began to emphasize the wording of this verse in a way I had not previously considered. Faith does not come simply because you have heard the Word at some point in the past. The Scripture does not say faith comes by having heard. It says faith comes by hearing and hearing. There is repetition involved. There is continuation involved.

Faith is not only received through hearing the Word; it is sustained through continued hearing. Many believers receive faith initially but allow it to weaken over time. They heard the Word, believed it, and acted on it for a season. Then, gradually, they stopped hearing it. Other voices began to compete for attention. Circumstances spoke louder than Scripture. Over time, doubt and reasoning began to erode what was once believed with confidence.

### **Acceleration And Faith**

Acceleration cannot take place where faith has been neglected. Faith does not originate in the mind. Faith resides in the human spirit. The mind does not produce faith, but it can interfere with it. A person can have a heart full of faith and still struggle to receive if the mind is continually yielding to doubt, fear, or unbelief. This is why hearing the Word is so important. The Word strengthens the spirit and brings the mind into agreement.

The Lord went on to show me that one of the greatest problems in the Body of Christ today is the failure to meditate on the Word of God. Confession of the Word is important, and it is biblical. Speaking the Word has its place. But confession alone is not enough.

*Meditation is what allows the Word to move from the head into the heart.* Until a person meditates on the Word, they cannot truly believe it. They may agree with it mentally, but belief is deeper than agreement. Belief is settled. Belief produces confidence. Belief produces action. Faith is always released in action in some form.

## Faith Sees The Answer

The Spirit of God revealed this to me. *“Until you believe that you already have it—you do not have it.”* That is so simple but very powerful. Mark 11:24 says, *“What things soever you desire when you pray believe that you HAVE received them and you shall have them.”* You believe that you already have it, then you have it.

I wrestled with this years ago after being told I would never be released from prison on parole. I had gotten saved on my third escape from prison and turned myself in to the authorities. I went back to prison as a born-again Christian on fire for the Lord Jesus Christ. I thought I would get out because I had become a Christian. That would prove to be foolish thinking. Several years after I turned myself in, I was sent an official document telling me that I would never be released from prison on parole! It was a wake-up call! I found that miracles don't happen just because you think they should or you want them too.

I prayed earnestly, and the Lord Jesus Christ told me what to do. He told me to write down faith scriptures on a piece of paper and read them out loud to myself over and over and over. Romans 10:17 tells us that faith comes by hearing God's Word. I meditated on them and confessed them. After several hours, I began to see myself outside the prison walls. I visualized myself walking out the gate and going home. Faith sees the answer! If you can see it, you will have it.

I kept doing this day after day with no positive reinforcement from anyone except God's Word. Many times, fear that I would not get out would come over me. I would fight the good fight of faith and resist it in Jesus' name! No one gave me any hope. All I had to cling to was the Word of God, and I hung on to it! I fought through all the anxiety, fear, doubt, and unbelief! Most of those days I didn't feel any excitement emotionally, but I would not quit!

I continued confessing and meditating on the Bible. I kept visualizing myself outside the prison walls. About three months later, the captain of the guards came and found me. He told me that the state had reversed their decision about me, and I was going home the following Monday! It will work for you if you work it and fight the good fight of faith!

*Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses. (1Tim. 6:12)*

You may ask, “Why doesn't it work for me?” It is simply because you do not do what I and many others have done to have a breakthrough in their lives. You are spiritually lazy, lethargic, and good for nothing when it comes to putting the Bible into practice in your life. You will go to the gym and work out like a person gone wild, but you will not exercise your faith. You will scroll for hours, but don't use your faith.

Many believers know what the Word says, but they do not believe it deeply enough to act on it consistently. Knowledge alone does not produce results. Meditation is what turns knowledge into conviction. Without meditation, faith remains shallow, and shallow faith will not support acceleration. Meditation does not require special ability or advanced understanding. It simply requires time and attention. It is taking the Word, thinking on it, speaking it quietly, and allowing it to shape the way we think. When meditation is neglected, faith becomes weak, even though the Word itself has not changed. He changes not; He is the same every single day.

The Lord impressed upon me that acceleration would require attention to the inner life. The soul—the mind, will, and emotions—must be brought under the influence of the Word of God. If the soul is left undisciplined, it will resist what the spirit is trying to receive.

Many believers live primarily from the mental and emotional realm. They evaluate everything based on what they see or how they feel. But faith does not operate in that realm. Faith operates from the spirit. When emotions dominate, faith is weakened. When reasoning dominates, faith is delayed. That is why we have to constantly meditate on the Word of God. That produces faith in our lives.

This explains why some believers struggle even though they sincerely love God. Their heart believes, but their thought life contradicts what they believe. Over time, this produces frustration. Acceleration requires agreement—agreement between the heart and the mind.

*But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. (Hebrews 11:6)*

Another issue the Lord emphasized is diligence. Many believers believe God exists, but they struggle to believe that *diligence produces reward*. If they truly believed God rewards diligence, they would be more consistent in spiritual things. Diligence is not striving; it is simply consistent obedience to spiritual principles.

One reason delay is common among believers is familiarity with truth. Over time, people can know too much and practice too little. Knowledge without action produces stagnation. When people are new to the Word, they often act quickly on what they know. As knowledge increases, action sometimes decreases. Familiarity replaces diligence. The Lord said acceleration would come where believers return to simple obedience, not complicated methods, not new techniques, but hearing the Word, meditating on it, and acting on it consistently. I have proved this in my life.

There have been seasons when I allowed these truths to slip—not because I rejected them, but because I became busy. Legitimate responsibilities crowded out spiritual disciplines. When that happened, progress slowed, even though God had not changed. When I returned to confession and meditation of the Word, things that had been dormant began to operate again. Gifts that had not manifested for some time began to function. Increase followed. That is acceleration.

As I continued to pray and meditate on what the Lord was showing me, He made it clear that this season of acceleration would also expose areas that have gone unattended. God is not doing this to condemn anyone, nor is He trying to point out faults. Exposure is not judgment; it is preparation. God exposes areas so they can be corrected, strengthened, and brought into alignment. This is your time of success, victory, prosperity, peace, and an increase of His anointing on your life.

### **World Events**

USA and world events will speed up during this time of acceleration. You are witnessing this in the news on almost a daily basis. The culmination of all of our Heavenly Father's plans, before the foundation of the earth, are taking place. Our government and governments of other nations are being shaken. There is an event coming on the horizon of time that will cause our nation to tremble. It will be brought to its knees, and the church will understand the error of its ways.

President Trump, even though he has been used by our Father, will not be able to stop it. In fact, he will be a key piece to the puzzle that will help bring it about. He will not even realize it until it takes place. Even though there is great prosperity, there will come days of sorrow upon our nation. Those who walk with and in the Spirit will be prepared, and those who don't will not.

Much of what is called being led by the Spirit today is nothing more than man's ego, self-importance, plans, and desires. Many will say to Him in that day, "Lord, I assumed it was your will." He will say, "You never listened to me, and it was not My will." The wasted years of wood, hay, and stubble will be revealed to them, and great regret and sorrow will come upon them like they have not known.

The kingdom of darkness, overseen by Satan, is working to lead Christians into error. Not just blatant uncontrolled sin, but also not obeying the word and will of God. That is why the Lord Jesus Christ spoke to me to have the seminar advertised below. It was not my idea. I did not want to do it. My thinking was that people won't listen anyway.
