PAST THISE CHRISTIANULY

For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him. (2 Corinthians 11:4)

On May 1, 2015, the Spirit of God came upon me and revealed that there was a *false gospel* being accepted by many in the church. I called it the "Past Tense Gospel." I knew it was a word of warning for anyone that had embraced this doctrine of devils.

Therefore, the nation fell into a cesspool of ungodly acts and the devil has the upper hand. The devil dominates the political realm, judicial realm, financial realm, social realm, military realm and most of the church world today. That is not a special revelation, anyone that is honest and sincere would have to admit that this is true.

FAITH HAS WORKS

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves:it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them. (Eph. 2:8-10)

Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. (James 2:20)

The great debate in the course of the Christian church is "faith versus works." It was the cause for the reformation, as Martin Luther's opinion on the matter differed from the Roman Catholic Church. The argument has been around for almost two thousand years, however, since both Paul and James thought it important to write explicitly on it.

The argument is about how a human being becomes justified and saved from his sins in order to go to heaven when he dies. One answer is that we work for our salvation through good deeds, observing sacred rites and traditions, and being obedient to the commandments of the church. The opposing answer (that was started by Martin Luther) is that we attain salvation through faith in God, so long as we believe in what Jesus did and are repentant of our sins, we will be saved.

I believe the Bible proves that both positions are fundamentally wrong, and that the debate as a whole is meaningless. The faith or works for salvation discussion is unnecessary when you read the Bible.

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Faith Without Works

It is impossible to have faith without works. James 2:17 states that "faith, if it hath not works, is dead." It is not just that having faith without works won't get you to heaven, but that a faith without works is dead, the faith becomes meaningless. The man who declares he has faith but does not follow Christ's commandments is a liar because there is no such thing as a true faith that has not works.

He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected:hereby know we that we are in him. He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked. (1 John 2:4-6)

Works Without Faith

Also, it is impossible to have works without faith. All good works can be traced back to faith in something. Christians who advocate a works only based salvation have some sort of conception and belief in God. There is no such thing as works without faith, just as there is no such thing as a faith that is without works.

The faith versus works argument arose from a misinterpreted understanding of what faith and belief means. When Jesus said "believe on me to be saved", he was not simply saying if you mentally agree with me being your Lord you are heaven-bound. If you can live like the devil and go to heaven, Satan will be there.

If you truly believe/have faith in something, your lifestyle will reflect that truth in every area. If someone truly believes that Jesus Christ is the son of God, they live according to His teachings. The faith versus works debate is meaningless because the two words mean the same thing. James correctly stated "shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works." (James 2:18)

I kept saying, "I know he is saved!" They would say, "How do you know?" I didn't have any natural way that I could think of to prove it, and I admitted it to them.



(Matthew 3:7-8, Matthew 7:18-21, Mark 7:20-23, 1Corinthians 6:9-11, Galatians 5:19-21, Ephesians 2:8-10, James 2:18-26, 1 John 3:8)

He said, "If Ted is born again, he will act like it right away and we will see a difference in the way he acts, because the Bible says so." When I got to Ted's cellblock he had a pile of papers and stuff on his bed. He saw me and smiled. He said, "I am throwing away my pornographic magazines, witchcraft books, tattoo needles, drugs, homemade prison knife and my cigarettes because I know the Lord doesn't want me to do those things anymore." No one told him to, he just knew to do it because he was born again. He wasn't cussing and velling at others like he used to either. He was a different man! His works did not save him. The works or actions came as a result of his faith in Jesus Christ. Faith/works is the same thing, not two different things. The Christian life is present tense, not past tense. If you believe in Christ you will not, presently, live like a sinner or disobey the Bible.
