LED BY HIS SPIRIT

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

(Romans 8:14)

Christians who are led by the Spirit of God will have success and avoid many problems in their lives. This applies to all ministry offices also. Being led by His Spirit can also mean the difference between life and death. You really can't be led by His Spirit unless you have a personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. The number one way the Lord leads us is by the inward witness in our spirit.

Examples Of The Inward Witness

During WWII, Corrie Ten Boom's family hid Jews in their home. One night, Corrie woke with a sudden, inexplicable dread and insisted everyone move the Jewish refugees from the hidden room to a safer spot in the attic. Hours later, Nazi soldiers raided the house, searching thoroughly—but found no one. The family's intuition, which Corrie attributed to divine prompting, saved six lives that night.

While serving as a missionary on the island of Tanna, in the South Pacific, in the 1880s, Scottish missionary John Paton felt a strong inner warning from God to flee his hut immediately. The sense was so strong that he could not ignore it.

Despite no visible threat, he and his wife ran into the jungle.

That night, a war party attacked their mission station, burning it to the ground. Paton later wrote in his

autobiography that the Holy Spirit's nudge saved them from certain death.

In 1987, my wife and I were asleep in the middle of the night. Suddenly, I was awakened by what seemed like a buzzer going off inside my spirit. I knew it was the Spirit of God alerting me to wake up. I heard noise outside our home and jumped out of bed. I turned on the lights and opened the door. A man that was trying to break into my truck took off running. He was trying to steal some valuable tools I had in my vehicle.

While in prison, as a born-again Christian, I was asleep in bed. Suddenly, I woke up with an alarming sense of danger. In my spirit I heard, "Get out of bed and go to the bathroom now!" It was urgent, and I immediately obeyed. Shortly afterwards, a convict with a homemade knife began stabbing another convict to death that slept right beside me. I knew if I had not obeyed, I might have been stabbed also.

Notice how it was an inward witness that led each one of these Christians. The Lord will guide you too, in all the affairs of your life.

In the early nineties, my wife and I were attending one of Dad Hagin's meetings. We had large financial needs concerning the ministry. We had both been praying about our situation. An offering was being received for needs that Kenneth Hagin Ministries had. We wanted to give a sizable amount, but we did not see how. Suddenly, in my spirit, I was led to sow \$7,000.00. It was an inward prompting and intuition. My mind raced wildly, thinking there was no way!

I turned to my wife and quietly told her what I sensed. A look of shock and amazement came on her face! She knew we didn't have the money readily available to sow that much. She thought about it and swallowed hard, then said, "Ok, but how?" Thank God for a faith-filled wife. We had the money, but it was owed for bills we had. We sensed we should sow our bill money. With trembling hands, we wrote a check for that amount, trusting God. In about a week, we received a check in the mail for \$47,000.00! That was the largest donation we had ever received up until that time. It was from a man who had never been in one of our meetings. I knew of him, but I did not know him. If we had not obeyed that inward witness, we would not have received that money. Thank you Lord for leading us!

The Spirit of God said, in October of last year, that we were entering a time of unprecedented prosperity. He also revealed that it would require unprecedented sowing. This year we have sown more than we ever have. We obeyed the inward witness.

Learning The Inward Witness

There are truths you need to understand to become proficient at knowing the inward witness. *First, you are a spirit being, you possess a soul, and you live in a physical body.* (1 Thess. 5:23) It will pay great dividends if you will meditate on that and say that out loud to yourself. It will also help you to become more spirit conscious. Do not say that you don't know the will of God, or you do not know what to do in a situation. You know what to do in your born-again spirit, but if you don't know the inward witness, you will not know it. Say, "The Lord is leading, guiding, and directing my steps."

Second, following the inward witness is a skill you develop; it is not a gift from God. Erroneously, there are those who think God has given someone a special gift so they can be led by His Spirit. That is not true; every Christian has the inward witness in their spirit, but they must develop the skill to know that witness or intuition. It comes with practice.

Many of us have had experiences where things did not turn out right. As we thought about it, we remembered that we had a sense that we were making the wrong decision when we made it. We knew we shouldn't have, but we placed reasoning over listening to the inward witness. We had regret, because we knew not to make that decision all along. We had the inward witness all along.

Many years ago, there were wonderful people who encouraged me to start a program to help people getting out of prison. I had not really thought about it until then.

They thought because of my background I would be the right person to do it. I began to meditate on it and pray about it. I had no inward witness that I should do something like that. I asked some people what they thought, and they thought it was a great idea. I started to justify it in my mind as I reasoned it all out. Over a period of time, I declared it must be the will of God that I start the program. I went into debt to purchase the building and land to do it. I went through a lot of challenges that I had never encountered before to get everything going. Once it got going, I had a sense of gloom every time I went to that building. Sometimes, I would drive there and continue on past the entrance and go somewhere else. I had a check or stop sign in my spirit about that place, and I did not want to be there.

After several years, it got so overwhelming that I went to the Lord Jesus in prayer and fasting. It took me a day or so to get my mind quiet so I could hear the Lord. Finally, I heard Him clearly say that He never told me to do it, and that is why I had that sinking feeling inside me every time I went there. He showed me how I had reasoned it out by listening to well-meaning people. I repented and asked for mercy. I also asked Him to show me what to do now. He told me to close the program a certain way in several steps. I did, and I was very relieved and had peace for the first time in several years. I never did anything else that He did not lead me to do!

May I add something here? There are Christians/ministers today who are doing good and great things in the name of Jesus, but the work is not from the direction of Jesus. That is exactly what I was doing. It was a wonderful work, but the work was not the will of God. Except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain who build it. Stop and seek God until you know what He wants you to do and do that. Nothing else.

It is easy to start a snowball rolling effect in ministry. The more the snowball rolls, the more snow it gathers and becomes larger. A minister has favor and gains a larger following, and things start to roll. Money seems to be no object, and they begin to think they are invincible. Prayer time is replaced with the busy activity of running the large organization. Then, the will of God starts being determined by how much money and how many people they have. This always ends up being overextended in all areas and being out of the will of God. Most of them never finish their race because they die prematurely.

Third, silence is a key to being led by His Spirit. "Be still and know that I am God," He said. The world around you is filled with noisy influence, especially social media. You have about 3,000 to 4,000 thoughts per hour, about 50 or so per minute. If you control your thoughts and become quiet in your thought life, spiritual things will become more real to you. Meditate on the Word of God.

Years ago, Dad Hagin knew of a man in East Texas whose family was so poor that he didn't have a pair of shoes until he was twelve years old. He had only a fifth-grade education. But way back when money was money, he had two million dollars. He made his money in investments. He said, "In many years of investing, I've never lost a dime."

Here's how he said he did it. He said, "When someone comes with an idea and wants me to invest in something, my first reaction is mental. So I have a big closet I go into and pray about it. I wait long enough to hear what my spirit says. My head may say, 'You'd be a fool to invest in that,' but if my heart says, 'Go ahead,' I do. Or, my head may say, 'You'd better get in on this one,' while my heart tells me, 'Don't do it.' So I don't. I don't pay any attention to my head. I just get in that closet and wait—all night sometimes. And sometimes I'm in and out of it for three days, just praying and reading my Bible, getting quiet so I can hear what my heart says."

You can see he got his mind quiet and listened to his spirit. You must and can do the same thing. This applies to anything you would like to know the answer to, not just money. In Romans 8:16 Paul said, "The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God." Too many times people think that this witness he is talking about is a physical something. It isn't. The Bible does not say the Spirit bears witness with our bodies. The Spirit of God leads us through our spirit.

Reason is the voice of the soul or mind. Your *conscious* is the voice of your spirit. If we go by feelings, we are going to be in trouble! Remember, reasoning in my mind caused me to miss God and start that program. It came out of my head, not my spirit. It may take you a little time to sort things out, but take the time to do so. You will develop to where you know what to do, almost instantly, in any situation.

Earlier this year, I was flying the RGM aircraft from Oklahoma, up north, to preach in another state. I was flying along and the flight levels as the aircraft is pressurized so you can fly at higher altitudes. Suddenly, the autopilot disengaged and an audible alarm began sounding. It said, "Warning! Low airspeed! Warning! Low airspeed!" I immediately went into action and grabbed the controls to stabilize the aircraft for level flight.

I glanced at my airspeed indicator, and it indicated only 95 knots. I had been cruising at about 240 knots just a few seconds earlier. I knew the aircraft was going to stall unless I got airspeed right away. I pushed the nose of the aircraft down, but my airspeed did not increase. My engine power indicators showed normal indications, and I knew I should not have low airspeed, based on that, unless something had badly gone wrong. Suddenly, I heard in my spirit, "Turn on the pitot heat!" I did, and immediately the airspeed normalized. The pitot tube had frozen over with ice, which affects the airspeed. The Spirit of God spoke to me through my spirit and helped me. He helps us.

(1 Corinthians 14:14a)*

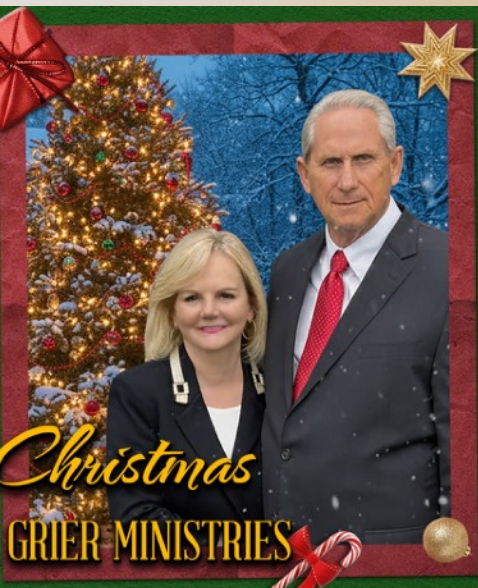
Praying in the Spirit is the *fourth* truth I want to share with you. I know from experience that praying in other tongues is one of the best ways to become more spirit conscious. Praying in other tongues helps your mind become quiet. You might have problems getting your mind quiet at first, but keep on until you succeed. As you pray in tongues, don't let your mind wander off and think whatever it wants. Set your mind on Jesus. Just think about Him, and your mind will eventually become quiet.

There have been more times than I can count where I was praying in other tongues and received the answer I needed. I will guarantee you that if you will sincerely seek God about an answer or direction you need, He will reveal it to you. I have proven it true in my life. You present your need to the Lord in your known tongue. Then start praying in other tongues. Pray with fervency until your mind gets quiet. If you could have figured it out in your mind, you wouldn't be praying about it. The answer is not in the mental realm; it is in the spiritual realm. That is why you pray in the spirit until you get the answer. *(end)*
